2. Quiz Mania




3. Fun Quest

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7. Debate AI:Boon or Bane:



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11. Bounce Back



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
12. Icon Riddles

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13. Hot Takes



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15. Youth Unite



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
18.Stand up comedy



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19.Debate-"Does Reservation Hold back progress?"


