So far there is no such facility to faculty on NeoCOLAB/NeoPAT platforms with coding problems.

In this connection, the faculty are advised to given in first-hand practice on MCQs, PAH and COD modules before conducting the lab sessions. This preparation will enable the faculty to guide students effectively, clarify doubts promptly, and ensure productive use of lab hours.

The courses covered under this initiative are:

2. Object Oriented Programming through Java – III Semester B.Tech
3. Python Programming – III Semester B.Tech
4. ADS (Advanced Data Structures) – III Semester B.Tech
5. PSD Lab (Basic C & Data Structures) – III Semester B.Tech
6. PSD Lab (Advanced C & Data Structures) – V Semester B.Tech

This initiative will enable faculty to:

- Practice problems under Practice at Home (PAH), Skill Builder (COD), Challenge Yourself (CY), and Concept Builder (MCQ) modules.
- Gain firsthand experience with coding challenges and issue resolution.
- Effectively guide students by anticipating and addressing possible difficulties.
