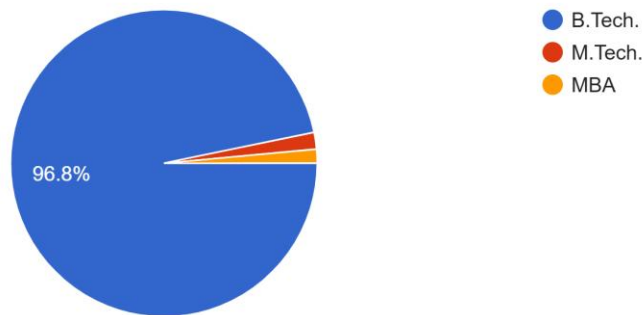

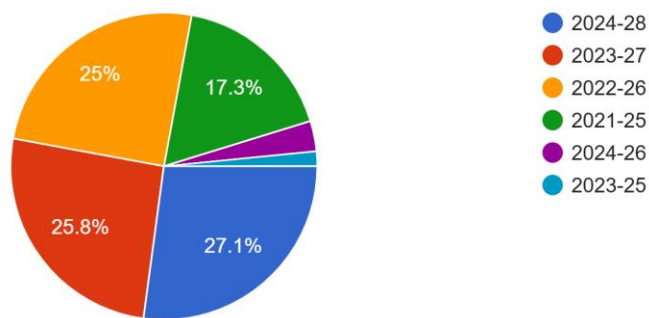

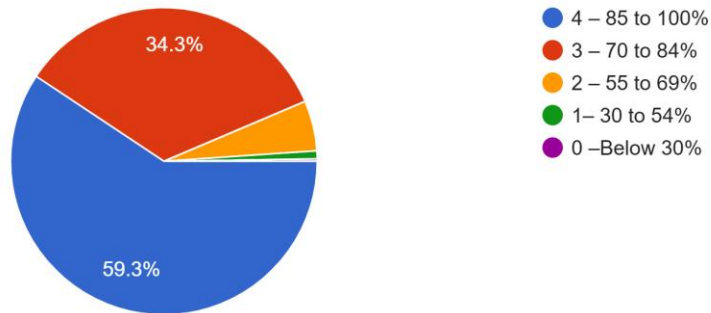

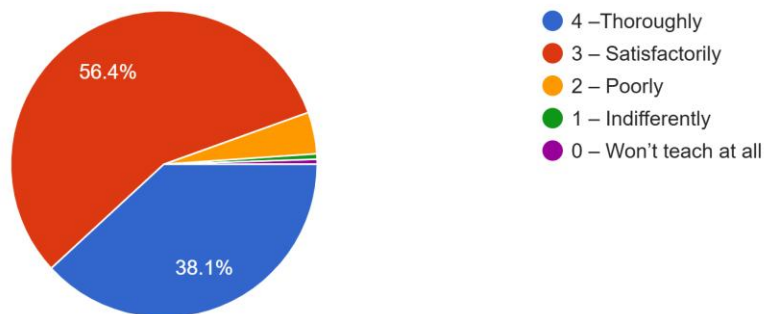
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

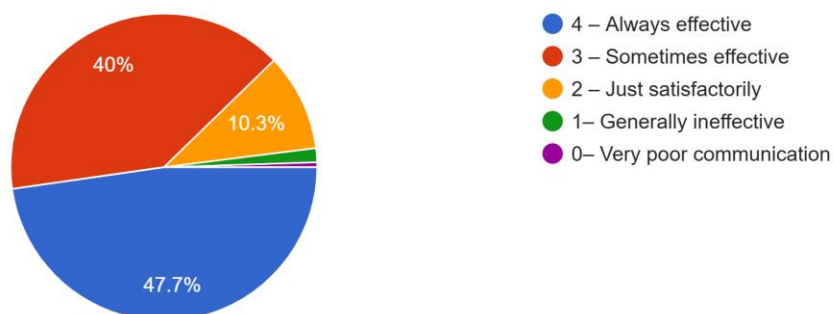

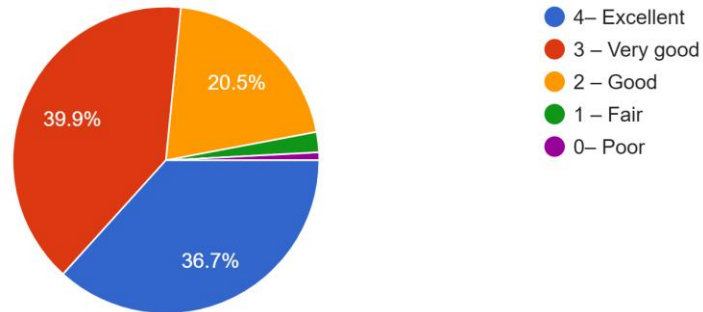

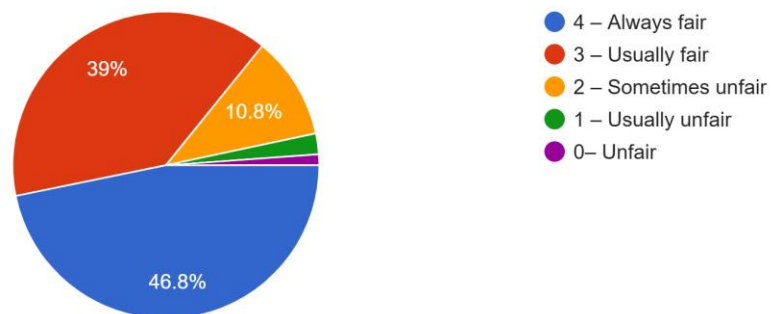
4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as -

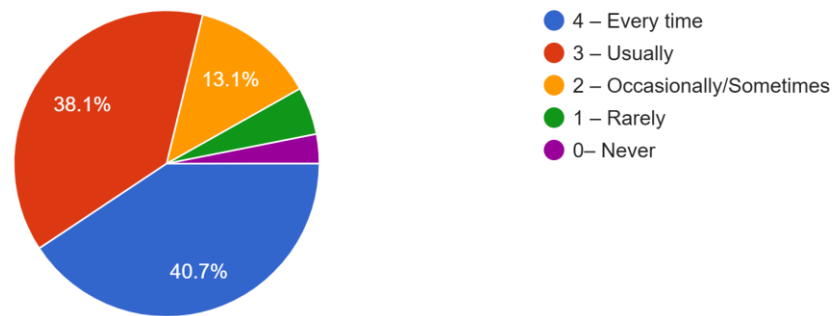

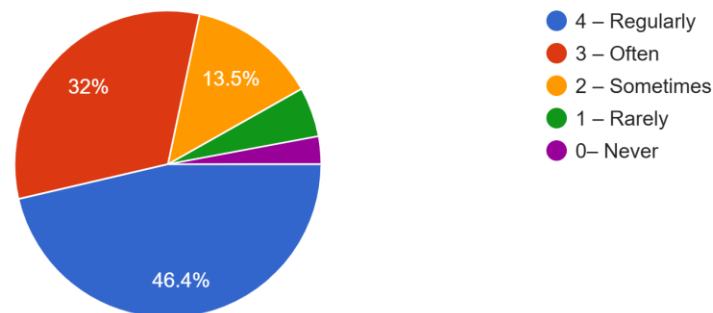

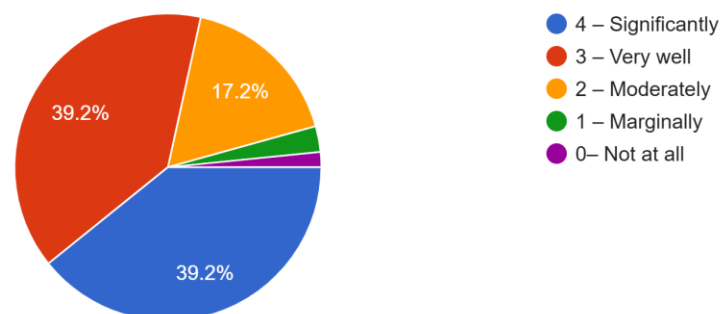

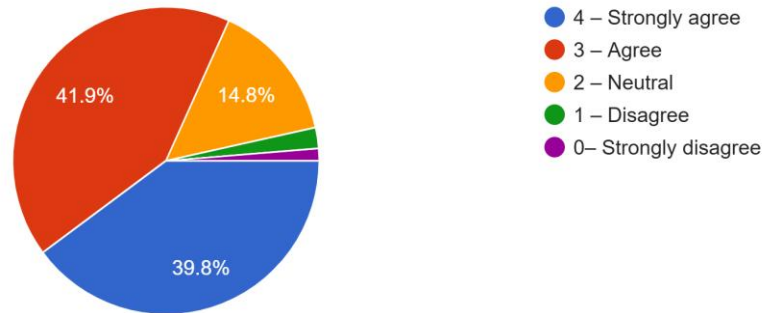

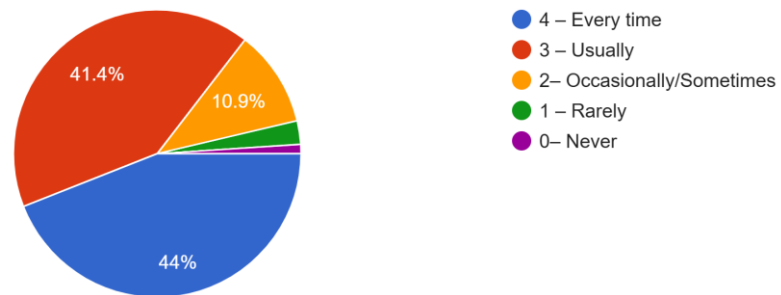

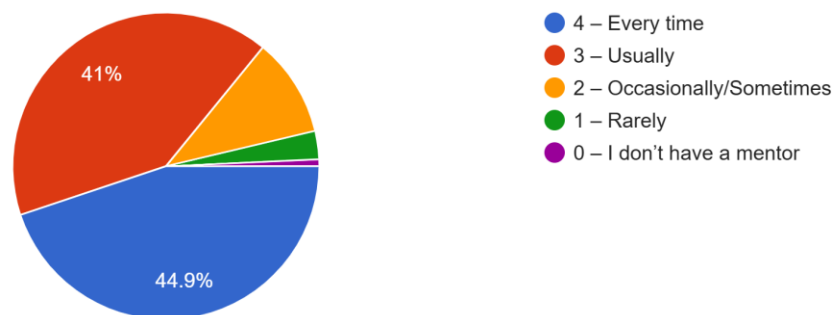

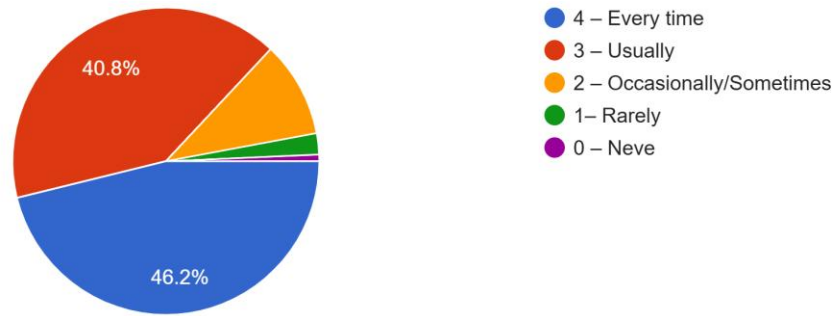

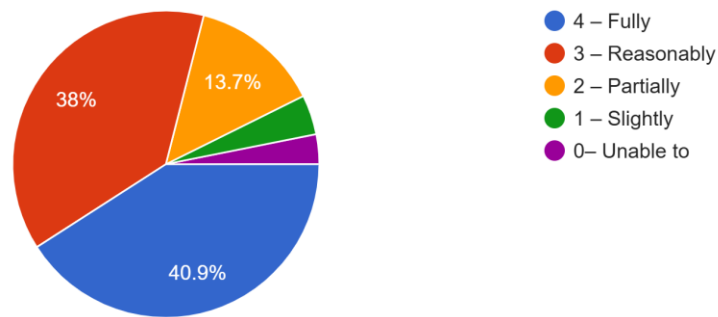

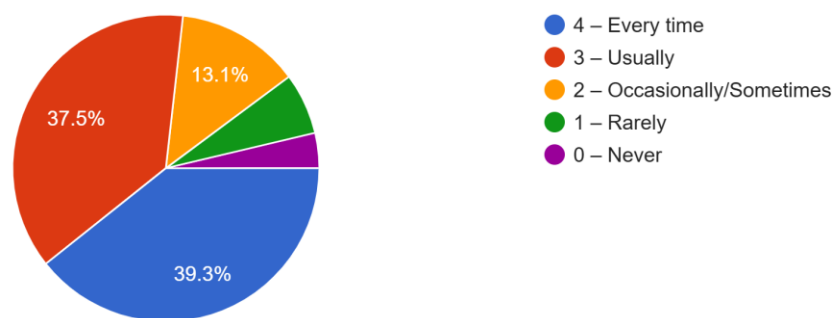

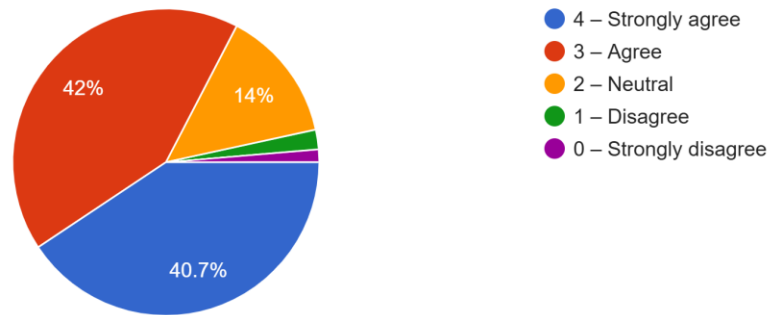

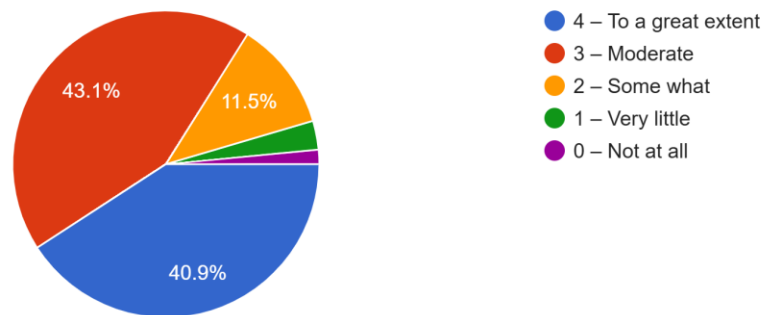

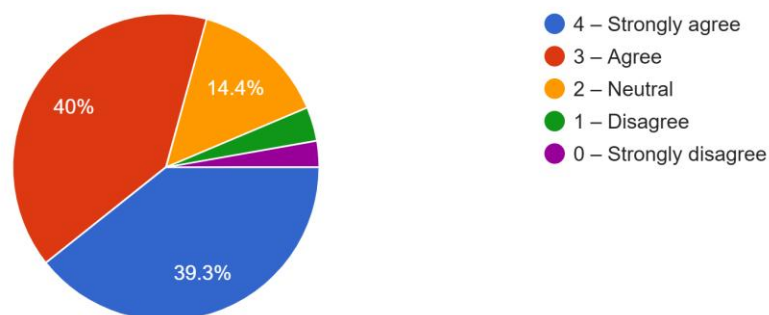

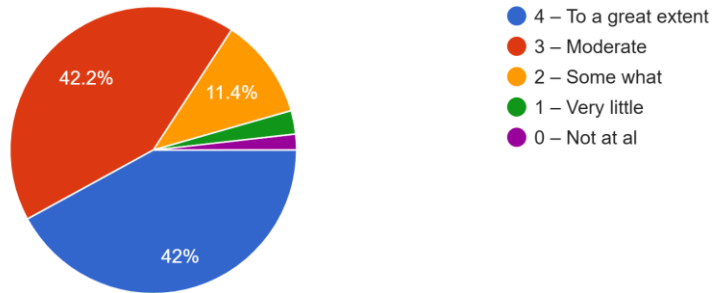

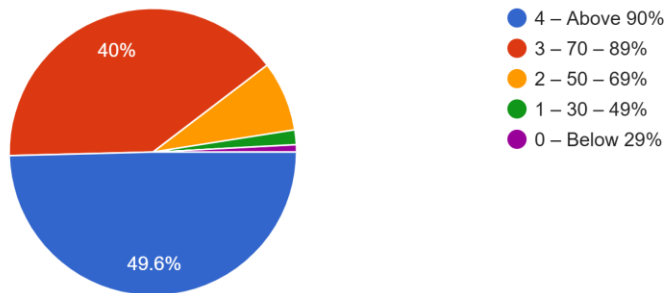

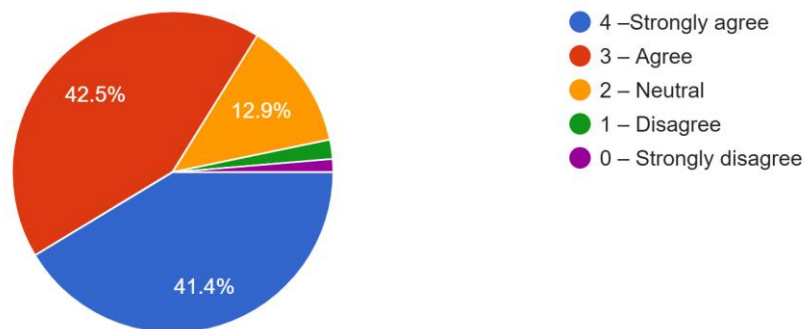
19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching?
