- **5. Preventing Recurrence:** Develop and implement strategies to prevent future rule violations and maintain a respectful and compliant community or organization.

- 5. **Documentation:** Keep records of all disciplinary cases, including evidence, hearings, and decisions.
- 6. **Conducting Hearings:**Organize and conduct disciplinary hearings to evaluate evidence and determine appropriate actions.
- 7. **Issuing Sanctions:** Decide and implement sanctions or penalties for rule violations, such as warnings, suspensions, or expulsions.
- 8. **Communication:**Communicate decisions and sanctions to relevant parties, including the individuals involved and any necessary authorities.

- 9. **Appeals Process:** Establish and oversee an appeals process for individuals dissatisfied with disciplinary decisions.
- 10. **Preventative Measures:**Develop and recommend strategies to prevent future violations and promote a culture of compliance and respect within the organization or community.
