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Model United Nations (MUN)

The literary and extramural club has organized the colossal event of our college “KITS MUN”. It is a three day event, wherein participants take up the role of delegate and represent a country. All the current global problems are discussed during this three day tenure. All the participants were trained thoroughly regarding KITSMUN beforehand. Three committees are set up namely United nations human rights council (UNHRC), Telangana assembly, United nations General assembly (UNGA). The agenda of United nations human rights council was “Deliberation on the potential human rights violation due to the Russia-Ukraine conflict”. At a time when the world is rife with abhorrent violations of human rights, the importance of United Nations Human Rights Council remains indispensable. There were two agendas for the Telangana assembly, where the first agenda was “Deliberation on possible restrictions on alcohol consumption in Telangana” and the second agenda was “Discussion land revenue problems in the state with special emphasis on agricultural sector and ease of doing business”. The state runs by the power of ministers, the assembly asserts over the council of ministers reminding them they are for the people and by the people, the Telangana assembly brings a platform for all the participants to discuss state’s current problems. The agenda of general assembly was “Russia-Ukraine conflict”. General assembly comes into existence to help participants address the violent extremism that have come into existence throughout the course of history and some extremist groups have managed to expand their violent presence beyond geopolitical boundaries.
