Russia, showing its superiority, but Ukraine is showing itself to be pathetic instead? Bangladesh raising motion for the agenda. Italy raised the motion for GSL. In the opening remarks, the U.K. was focused on Russia possessing the weapons.

"Russia represents trust and friendship" and promotes peace by strengthening itself; "but, because Ukraine is not in support of us, defence is our first priority," Russia defends.



We support proliferation of nuclear weapons, the statements by the panelists' countries in GSL. Iran prioritises relations and Islamic work. Turkey is working on more than 700 defence projects, has launched military interventions, has 14 of the largest exports in the world, and wants no problems with its neighbours. UAE speaking in the discussion: the economy of the country demands peace, so stop the war! At 1:00 p.m., an unmoderated caucus was passed by Russia. Syria and Iran support Russia, and concern was expressed that the USA is the reason for uninvited wars across the globe.

HRC's periodic review on fundamental rights and homogenising the catastrophe

"Urging the United Nations member states to heed the call of Iranian women and remove community-based rules in the country. Let them decide what they wear-No law on the hijab!"

HRC holds confounding discussions on hijab, fundamental rights, and religion. Thematic Study on Women's Rights, Women's Boundaries to Religion, and Freedom of Choice from sharply escalating inclusion on Human rights under the name of Religion. Violation of human rights in the Middle East. France, a member of NATO, signed a 4-year treaty to stop violence against its civilians. In Cameroon, their property laws are so standard, and those that are for individuals are so strong, debate proceeds. All the laws in the Maldives are based on Sharia. The constitution does not provide for any right to freedom of religion or belief. "Participation of women and minorities from middle east in politics," the motion was adjourned.

The USA raised another motion, "Law Violation and Freedom of Speech in Iran with Luch Delegate to Speak for 90 Seconds," and argued that 250 people were brutally executed in Iran.

"You try to create laws on a human not based on women in hijab, specific", Argentina suggested Iran.

A rising toll of protesters has been killed by the Iranian authorities since nation-wide protests were triggered by the tragic death of 22-year-old.



Mahsa Jina Amina, who was arrested and detained by Iran's morality police for failing to properly cover her hair, died.

"Women are the victims of patriarchal culture, but they are also its carriers. Let us keep in mind that every oppressive man was raised in the confines of his mother's home, and Iranian women are very courageous and active, even with all the oppression!"

AIMIM leaders, along with rival team passed the comments which were offensive. Confused yet aggressive opposition parties passed the factual inaccurate statements. The decorum was completely disturbed in the assembly. Many more warnings were thrown at each other. Sabitha Indra Reddy questioned the background of P.M and raised her voice. Opposition questioned the former governments' work leisure: "Corrupters are most welcome into the government to rule the state?", further

The opening statement was passed by India, with its main motive "being to promote peace and raise voices against injustice". Adding to that, China said that it

"wants to be part of developing nations and believes in nations".

Russia said in its opening remarks that "we have a threat of losing our country; we need to be technically updated."

U.K raised its statement on Russia that it didn't sign the non-proliferation treaty

Adding on to the statements, Denmark raised a question in the G.A that, if Russia is the strangest, from what is it defending itself?

Russia stated that reasons for the wars is USA because of its military operations and questioned USA that why is it supporting Ukraine for funding.

USA in the point of negotiations questioned Russia invading Ukraine in the name of defending.

The quick statement passed by Russia was that it is in the process of demilitarization not invading !!

While Morocco raised the point of information and stated that it uses weapons for good will, Ukraine raised the point that Russia is a part of European countries and that NATO will never attack Russia.

Spain adding on the statements passed by Ukraine, quoted "Russia has largest number of nuclear weaponry".

As the Israel quoted that Russia is doing an unjustified war, Russia questions in return to Israel why it so worried about Ukraine?

Syria raised point of information to the Chair and questioned about Israel bombing Syrian airports.

The session moved on to the moderated caucus. The series of sessions were held with Russia, France, and the UK raising the Mod caucus. Between the series of discussions on war-torn nations, Pakistan raised the question of why India had illegally occupied Kashmir.

India, in its comeback, has seriously stated that "Pakistan itself occupied J&K"

Adding to the speakers list Bangladesh quoted that the country is always ready to help the world peace. Costa Rica, in support of Russia, stated that

"Russia has always been criticized for its own rights."

Ukraine on direct statement to Russia, "Stop thinking that the USA is your competitor". Italy on a high note passed statements questioned that "if Russia can't gain trust of its own people, how can Russia gain trust of other countries!" Russia countered on the statements of Italy, China on the last remarks stated that it believes in betterment of UN and is not a threat for the future.

Day-2 session's agenda with a moderated caucus are:

"U.S.A quoting that it has given military aid to Ukraine during the war."

Germany quoted, it has businesses in Ukraine and extended its medical aid to Ukraine but Congo raised a P.O.I, subjecting Germany did not send any medical aid to Ukraine during the war. Cote d'Ivoire quoted Russians torturing Ukraine's prisoners, which clearly violated international humanitarian laws. Russia does not want Ukraine to join NATO and said that "There are new targets in Europe and the current leader of Ukraine is running anti-Russian forces, so Russia wants to make sure Ukraine never becomes a member of NATO."

and concluded that it is feeling insecure because of its border countries. Only the UNSC can declare the use of force. The USA raised the P.O.I, "How can Russia declare war being a V.E..T.O power that preserves peace?" At this phase, the guest delegate has arrived the committee and answered USA that

"Russia felt threatened and said that as Ukraine is its brother country, it has a complete control over Ukraine",

adding to this, Russia questioned "wouldn't India feel insecure if military troops of China were placed in Sri Lanka?"

Russia also said that "our country has a sufficient military base and can protect itself, and we do not feel the need to join NATO." USA agrees that it supports all the countries to increase their military power,

but not provoking others for a war, contradicting its own stand. France raised a point of information: even if Ukraine joins NATO, the USA has the capability of attacking Russia. Vietnam quoted: "During the Russia-Ukraine war, bodies were found burned, girls and women were raped by the Russian soldiers, and they were treated brutally." During the GSL, Egypt quoted, "it is protecting human rights in its country." Congo raised a P.O.I about the rising number of political prisoners in Egypt and asked about the arrest of Alaa Abd eh-Fattah. Belgium quoted itself as providing its

citizens with quality education, healthcare, and women's protection, adding that it allowed Ukraine refugees to live with them during the Russia-Ukraine war. In the second half, the agenda was changed to "Menstrual Hygiene and Health in Middle Eastern and European Countries." Iran quoted that "All the netizens of Iran are provided with basic menstrual education and are well aware of menstrual hygiene and mentioned that the government provides women with the disposable sanitary pads". Maldives quoted that the govt follows criminal law and gives 2nd priority to sharia law. Pakistan raised the point of order and quoted that all Islamic countries follow sharia law.

G. O proposed by an agenda went on "Development of Telangana: Proposed by BRS Party MLA T. Harish Rao. Today's T.A. was very dynamic. Every M.L.A were right into the discussion. But few of the M.L.As did not maintain the decorum of the Assembly. After giving many warnings, they were suspended from the assembly by the E.B. Two M.L.A.s have slipped their

tongues today in the Assembly, verriah the MLA of INC has said that Sonia has sacrificed her life for the country and then corrected as Indhira Gandhi and Shakeel stated about mission bhaghiratha scam and then furtherly corrected as scheme. Cross-talk was all over the sessions. K.C.R. claimed that his government is having reporting issues regarding domestic abuse cases in the villages but failed to show proof when E.B. asked. Even so, he confidently claimed that there are no wine shops within a radius of 1 km of educational institutions and temples. K.C.R. also claimed that they have only increased the alcohol rates so that poor people cannot afford it. So, EB questioned KCR about the fact that poor people have given their lives by consuming sanitizer, and KCR was unable to answer it.



Shakeel the MLA, BRS stated that temporary workers in mission Bhaghiratha were not suspended after the project but were recruited in some other projects, which was proven false by the EB. K.C.R. has stated that 1 crore is nothing for the MLAs of the B.R.S. party. And he also stated that "parajala sommu finaledhu" and he was asking EB, "Don't I have 1000 acres of land?" "Don't I have side businesses for the income?" and EB asked to keep the assets of KCR for them. Many MLAs have slipped their tongues and was Suspended by the EB. M.L.A.s. Shakeel, Sridhar Babu, Sai Anno, Narendar, and Harish Rao's statements were completely irrelevant to the topic.

"Telangana Assembly Passes Anti-Corruption Bill 2023 with Stringent Measures"

The Telangana Assembly passed a ground-breaking bill aimed at combating corruption in the state on the day of its proposal. The Prevention of Corruption 2023 bill, proposed by the ruling party, contains several measures designed to prevent and punish corrupt practices. The bill received overwhelming support from the Assembly, demonstrating the government's commitment to creating a more transparent and accountable society. The opposition party's bill was not elected for discussion due to a lack of a majority. The passing of this bill demonstrates the government's commitment to fighting corruption and promoting transparency in the state. With these new measures in place, the people of Telangana can now play a more active role in the fight against corruption. One of the bill's key provisions is "the punishment of bribe-givers and takers". This sends a clear message that corruption will not be tolerated and that everyone involved in such practices will face the consequences. *The bill also establishes a toll-free number and WhatsApp number for reporting corruption, encouraging the public to play an active role in the fight against corruption.*

Another important provision of the bill is the reward system for reporting corruption.

"The bill encourages citizens to report any corrupt practices they may witness by providing a cash reward of INR 5,000 for providing evidence."

This incentivizes people to come forward with information and helps ensure that corrupt officials are held accountable for their actions. The bill also includes the appointment of an intelligence officer in each ward to monitor government departments and schemes. This will provide a further layer of oversight and help ensure that all government programmes are implemented transparently and held accountable. In conclusion, the Telangana Assembly's decision to pass the Prevention of Corruption 2023 bill is a positive step towards creating a more transparent and accountable society. With its stringent measures and reward system, the bill sends a clear message that corruption will not be tolerated and that everyone involved in such practices will face consequences. This will provide a further layer of oversight and help ensure that all government programmes are implemented transparently and held accountable.

Any official found to be involved in corruption will be suspended from duty for five years and will have their promotions and benefits from the government cancelled.

"HRC grandly passes working paper proposed by the U.S.A"

The session has begun with the general speakers list speeches by delegate of Madagascar, Argentina, South Africa, Cote D'Ivoire, Eritrea. Then a motion has raised for unmoderated caucus. The delegates have lobbied around and discussed topics for the moderated caucuses and working paper.

"Saudi Arabia is birth place of Islam; Iran and Saudi exploited South Africa. For a time period of 7 years, South Africa imposed on Yemen. By the end of 2021, an approximate of 3770 people were killed. Argentina quoted, 17.8 million people, lacked access to safe water, sanitation, and hygiene services. Maldives quoted, 'There is an economic collapse, and 23.8% of the people need humanitarian services'." Again, the formal debate is suspended, and an unmoderated caucus motion was passed. As the session was about to its end, countries have voted no for the draft and press release, and the majority has voted for the working paper. The U.S.A, Congo, and Czech Republic voted for making a working paper. With a majority of 28 votes, the U.S.A's working paper was passed. And the committee was a huge success.



In conclusion, the Telangana Assembly's decision to pass the Prevention of Corruption 2023 bill is a positive step towards creating a more transparent and accountable society. With its stringent measures and reward system, the bill sends a clear message that corruption will not be tolerated and that everyone involved in such practices will face consequences. The people of Telangana can now play an active role in the fight against corruption, helping to create a brighter future for the state. In the press conference of the assembly, the questions raised by the press went unanswered by many MLAs. The response from the MLAs did not go well for the media. KT Rama Rao contradicting the statements he spoke about of asking share in the Adani scam was today asking for the video proof that he hasn't said the statement.

"Media requested KCR and KTR not to address Media as their friends"
Narendar Reddy, Sridhar Babu, and Malla Reddy remained silent and were unable to answer the questions raised by the press. Malu Bhatti Vikramala stated that the ACB (Anti-corruption bureau) Site introduced by Telangana Government was not functioning since many days. The opposition parties walked out of the assembly as their bill was not discussed in the assembly.

After the unmoderated caucus, the delegate of Congo raised a motion to suspend the informal session and move into formal debate on the topic, "Domestic Hatred Against Women in the Middle East and European Countries." Delegate of Sudan quoted, *"The country preserves its dignity and equality. The people of Sudan are provided with healthcare and education. People are provided access to development."*

Cote D'Ivoire quoted, *"The country has got its independence in 1960 and the new constitution has been adapted in 2016. The government is conducting regular elections and making sure to protect and preserve the rights of women and children."* A second unmoderated caucus topic has been raised by Argentina, "Human rights violations in Yemen," including 9.2 million children. The delegate of USA quoted, *"Saudi Arabia is birth place of Islam; Iran and Saudi exploited South Africa. For a time period of 7 years South Africa imposed on Yemen. By the end of 2021 an approximate of 3770 people were killed. The delegate of Argentina quoted, '17.8 million people, The delegate of USA quoted, "*

"The prevalence of the Anti-Russian Sentiment"

The session began with intense GSL speeches of various countries, which were completely in accord with their respective country's foreign policies. After each GSL speech, countries were so confident in answering the questions that were presented to them. The delegates whose foreign policies contradict each other, engaged in an interesting dialogue with each other, took no chance in not answering the questions presented to them. After the GSL, a motion for unmoderated caucus had been raised. Further, the United Kingdom and Russia indulged in a formal debate regarding Russia's statement "Russia aims at nurturing the notion of security of other countries." After the suspension of the formal debate, a motion for unmoderated caucus was proposed to prepare the draft resolution. Delegates carefully crafted the draft resolution representing the interests of the whole committee. The committee escalated on the third day. After engaging in the discussion with the committee the draft resolution was passed which was approved by a simple majority of the delegates. The committee was then suspended.
