It is a self-financing co- education institution affiliated to the Kakatiya University (KU), Warangal and is the first private engineering college in the Telangana region. The institute also has the distinction of being the first institute in the country to offer a B. Tech program in Electronics & Instrumentation Engineering since 1981.

Started as an Undergraduate institution, KITSW has recorded an impressive progress and today it is a full fledge Post graduation institution with 7B. Tech., programs, 7 PG programs. Four academic departments (CE, ME, EIE & CSE) are recognized as the research centres by the Kakatiya University, Warangal to offer doctoral programs. KITSW became an Autonomous Institution w.e.f the academic year 2014-15. The Under Graduate Programs (with an intake of 1020 per year) leading to B.Tech are Civil Engineering (120), Computer Science & Engineering (180), Electronics & Electronics Engineering (120), Electronics & Instrumentation Engineering (60), Electronics & Communication Engineering (180), Computer Science & Engineering (Networks) (60) and Electronics Communication & Instrumentation Engineering (60). The Post Graduate Programs (with an intake of 205 per year) leading to M. Tech are Structural & Construction Engineering (24), Design Engineering (24), Digital Communication (25), Software Engineering.


